VEAL—"A" GRADE "A" Grade veal shall be derived from prime fully fed calves of not more than four months of age, weighing from 70 pounds to 135 pounds CDW. The carcasses shall be pale pink, well finished and free from bruising and taint.	A VEAL
VEAL—"B" GRADE "B" Grade veal shall be derived from calves of not more than four months of age. Carcasses shall be light of finish but of fair average flesh and conformation, free from bruising and taint, and may include carcasses over-weight for "A" Grade to a maximum of 150 pounds CDW.	B VEAL
